



## 2022 CARTER WICKWIRE PHILANTHROPY AWARD CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

The Jackson Community Foundation (JCF) established the Carter Wickwire Philanthropy Award in 2018 as a part of celebrating our history of humble beginnings and 70 years of service and impact in the Jackson community. JCF was founded in 1948 with two very special gifts. During World War II, the families of Lt. John L. Carter and Pfc. John Gilbert Wickwire donated proceeds from life insurance policies that were purchased in the name of their sons, both of whom lost their lives in battle. The Jackson War Chest accepted the insurance contribution, plus additional gifts added by each family. When discussion of starting a community foundation began, a total of \$20,000 was transferred to begin a permanent endowment for Jackson County, now called the Jackson Community Foundation.

**The Carter and Wickwire Philanthropy Award** honors a living individual or couple for service as a volunteer, a board member, or a donor who made a significant effort to help grow our community through philanthropy in Jackson County.

### SELECTION AND RECOGNITION

Nominations are due annually in December. A committee will review all nominations and select the award winner. The recipient will be honored at the JCF and Jackson County Chamber of Commerce Annual Meetings.

If the nominee has served as a **trustee and donor** of JCF, they may also be nominated for the **Community Foundation Philanthropy Award**. The Council of Michigan Foundations (CMF) and the Michigan Nonprofit Association (MNA) established this Award in 2006 to honor a living individual or couple for their service as both volunteer/trustee and donor to help grow community philanthropy in Michigan on behalf of one or more community foundations.

### NOMINATION PROCESS AND GUIDELINES

Nominations will be accepted for a living individual or couple who have demonstrated commitment, leadership, impact, creativity and collaboration through service and philanthropy.

**Please attach no more than 3 pages to the nomination form that describe the individual or couple's:**

- **Commitment:** List the nominee's length of service to the Jackson Community or JCF.
- **Leadership:** Describe how the nominee has demonstrated volunteer leadership as a board member or volunteer service in the community.
- **Impact:** Describe three to five ways in which the nominee has made a difference in his/her commitment to Jackson County through their time and giving.
- **Creativity/Advocacy:** Describe the nominee's support of innovative ideas in Jackson's nonprofit and public sectors through their involvement.
- **Collaboration:** Provide examples of how the nominee has supported collaborative work of the Jackson Community.

Please submit the attached nomination form, including contact information for two individuals who can serve as references for the nominee **and** no more than 3 pages that describe the individual or couple's Commitment, Leadership, Impact, Creativity/Advocacy, and Collaboration as described above. References should have a comprehensive knowledge of the individual and or couple's background, accomplishments and community impact.
