

Privacy Policy

I. Privacy Statement

This website is owned and operated by Jackson Community Foundation. Our intention is to inform and educate visitors about our work as a grantmaker, community convener and collaborator and as a philanthropic partner to individuals, families, and organizations. Jackson Community Foundation is committed to honoring the privacy of all those we work with, including visitors to our website and subscribers to our electronic newsletters.

II. Personal Information

Your right to privacy is very important to us. We recognize that providing Jackson Community Foundation with your personal information is an act of trust. When you visit Jackson Community Foundation online, you remain anonymous, as we do not require registration to view our website or access information.

We may occasionally ask for your feedback via surveys or other communications to better understand your interests and needs. We may also request information through online forms used to register for foundation events or other activities. The foundation does not share or make public any personal information gathered through our website.

If you are a Jackson Community Foundation fund holder and you use our online portal, FUNDWEB, we provide a secure password to access your fund information and initiate fund distributions. That information is only used on this site and is not distributed to any other party or site. We may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external partners with grant opportunities that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your personal information is not shared with external partners. Our secure system for donors is encrypted with Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) Class 3, High-grade Encryption (RC4 128 bit) to provide security and privacy when you access fund information, initiate online fund transactions or send secure messages.

III. Public Information

Under IRS Code, the following foundation documents are public information:

- IRS Forms 990 and affiliated schedules for the past three years.
- Exemption letter from the IRS.
- Approved application for exemption with supporting documentation.

We do not reveal the name of anonymous donors to the recipient of a grant.
